## **Registration Information**

Every prospective parent and student for kindergarten through eighth grade is asked to meet with our principal, Mrs. Joanne Fitzgerald, prior to registration. This meeting will give the principal an opportunity to answer your questions and to learn more about your child. Parents should bring copies of recent report cards, standardized and state test scores, and any pertinent information regarding special services to this meeting.

Students transferring into Grades K through 8 are asked to spend an hour with their prospective class prior to registration. Children registering for kindergarten will spend some time in one of our pre-kindergarten classes. In addition, students will take part in a brief meeting/evaluation with a faculty member. Students will not be admitted into the school until this has taken place. These visits are arranged through our principal and the main office.

## **Checklist for Registration**

- \$100 Non-Refundable Registration Fee
- One Copy Each of Baptismal Record, Birth Certificate, Social Security Card
- Proof of Immunization
- Most Recent Report Card (if applicable)
- Completed Registration Form
- Copies of any IEP or 504 reports, in addition to copies of the most recent report card and standardized and state test scores. (These papers should be submitted prior to registration so that each child's individual needs can be properly addressed.)

## **Registration Information Regarding Early Childhood**

Nursery: Our nursery program for three year olds is being planned for five mornings or afternoons a week. Parents may also choose to just participate in a three day program on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, within the five-day class. The hours are 9:30 to 11:50 AM or 12:30 PM to 2:50 PM. A full-time assistant, as well as, an experienced New York State certified teacher and a small class setting provide a fine quality of education for every student. All children must be toilet-trained prior to entering the Nursery Program. All children must be three by December 1, 2010 for the 2010-2011 school year.

Pre-Kindergarten: Our pre-K program is aimed at helping each student develop all the skills needed for kindergarten. Our pre-K is being planned to offer three options: a five-day full-day program, from 9:30 AM to 2:50 PM; a four-day extended morning program (Monday – Thursday, 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM; or a three-day extended morning option (Monday – Wednesday, 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM) is offered within the four-day program. A full-time assistant, as well as, an experienced New York State certified teacher, and a small class setting provide a fine quality of education for every student. All children must be four by December 1, 2010 for the 2010-2011 school year.

Kindergarten: St. Edward School offers a full-day kindergarten program, which is taught by an experienced full-time New York State certified teacher. The teacher is joined in the classroom by a full-time aide. Students residing within a 15-mile radius of the school are offered bus transportation through their respective school districts. All children must be five by December 1, 2010 for the 2010-2011 school year.
